



Approval for Non-Specified Food and Food Ingredients Draft Regulation / Key Recommendations

Draft Regulation Highlights

Indian Food Regulator floated draft regulation to approve non-Specified Food and Food Ingredients.

The proposed draft will establish the procedure to approve ingredients and additives which are not defined under the Food Safety Act 2006.

These products will require prior approval from FSSAI. The various categories of food products covered under this category are:

- Novel food or food containing novel ingredients not having a history of human consumption in the country
- Food ingredients with a history of human consumption in the country but not specified in any other regulations made under the Act
- New additives and processing aids
- Food manufactured or processed with the use of novel technology

Key Recommendations

Leveraging the regulation to augment positive list of Ingredients and Additives of the Nutraceutical Regulation -

- Advocating for a separate path to fast tracks the approval of ingredients currently allowed in the market (PA/NOC) but not mentioned in the Nutraceutical Regulation.
- Simplified and time bound process to approve ingredients and additives.
- Support and encourage innovation through a possible period of Exclusivity.
- Suggested to define negative or adverse effects to avoid misinterpretation; else replace with Serious Adverse Events.
