SOUTH AFRICA



- SIZE OF RSA MARKET: +8 billion rand
- GROWTH: +15%
- POPULATION: 50 million

CURRENT SITUATION LEGISLATION



- Fully pharmaceutical approach to:
 - Registration process is via za CTD document
 - All CAMS products including health supplements need stability data on all raw materials, as well as the finished product.
 - Manufacture requires full GMP
 - Licences at every level
- Claims and levels
 - Allowable claims have been published in a recent guideline document for amino acids, proteins, fats, oils, probiotics, vitamins & minerals
- Strengths have also been published in a GG Guideline

CURRENT SITUATION LEGISLATION



- HPA is working closely with MCC TO MAKE THE PROPOSED DRAFT REGULATIONS MORE SUITABLE FOR THE CAMS INDUSTRY.
- Proposed changes have been submitted to MCC end April.
- Workshops are being held to assist industry to understand how to implement the regulations (MCC will assist in the process)
- HPA is seeking support and advice from IADSA and is in regular contact.
- It is hoped that IADSA will attend future workshops as speaker.

CURRENT SITUATION LEGISLATION



- No new products are being launched.
- No imports are taking place
- "Gridlock" situation exists
- Market growth is at 15 % despite lack of new products.
- Potential is very large, not only in RSA but in the surrounding AFRICAN COUNTRIES.
- Potential for harmonised regulations presents very big opportunities.
