



NEW ZEALAND

Still waiting for their own model for regulation. No way in which they will take the Australian model. Dietary supplement regulation in transition? Discussion around potential product listing.

CHINA

Increase scrutiny on Health Foods Discussions on future administration approach.

BREXIT

Lack of clarity. Challenge to plan for multiple potential events.

Major progress in regulation over the past decade. Pacific Alliance harmonisation still a key priority.
